

TUALATIN 1 MG C-2 RESERVOIR AND  
IMPROVEMENTS TO THE C-1 RESERVOIR

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Sealed proposals for the construction of the new welded steel 1 MG C-2 Reservoir and improvements to the C-1 Reservoir will be received by the City of Tualatin (County of Washington, State of Oregon) until the 4th day, November, 2014, at 2:30 p.m., local time, at the Tualatin City Offices, 18880 S.W. Martinazzi Avenue, Tualatin, Oregon, 97062. Kaaren Hofmann is the designee to receive the proposals. Bids will not be received after such date and time.

First Tier Subcontractor's Disclosure forms are required to be provided no later than 2 hours following the proposal due time. Proposals will be rejected if the list is not submitted within the designated time.

Bids will be publicly opened and read at 2:30 p.m. on the 4th day, November, 2014, at the Tualatin City Offices.

Major items of work consist of all associated improvements for the construction of a new 1 MG C-2 Welded Steel Reservoir, improvements to the C-1 Reservoir and site work.

Bidding documents may be obtained via the City's virtual website at <http://bids.tualatinoregon.gov/>. The plan holder's list will be published and updated on this same website.

Bidders must be prequalified, specific to this Project, with the City of Tualatin in compliance with Chapters 279A and 279C of Oregon Revised Statutes and the project specifications. Prequalification applications, available on the City's virtual website, shall be filed no later than 12:01 p.m., Tuesday October 21st, 2014 to be considered.

A mandatory prebid meeting for prequalified contractors will be held at the Project site, Tualatin, Oregon, at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, October 24th, 2014.

No proposal for a construction contract shall be received or considered by the City unless the firm is registered with the Construction Contractors Board.

Proposals must be made upon the proposal forms bound in the Contract Documents and must be accompanied by a certified check or proposal bond payable to the City of Tualatin (County of Washington, State of Oregon) in an amount not less than 10 percent of the total amount proposed.

This is a contract for a public work subject to ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870. State prevailing rate of wages, in place at the time of the bid opening must to be paid on this project in accordance with ORS 279C.840, and that the Contractor must ensure that the employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, marital status, age, or disability. No proposal will be received or considered unless the proposal contains a statement by the contractor as part of their proposal that the provisions of ORS 279C.825 will be complied with. The contractor is required to pay a fee to the Bureau of Labor and Industries pursuant to the provisions of ORS 279C.825. The fee is one-tenth of one

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percent of the price of this contract, but not less than \$100 nor more than \$5,000, regardless of the Contract price.

The proposal must indicate whether the contractor is a resident contractor, as defined in ORS 279A.120.

Notice is hereby given that the work site contains permit-required confined spaces, and that permit space entry is allowed only through compliance with a permit space program meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 437--Department of Insurance and Finance, 1919.146 Permit Required Confined Spaces and/or the requirements of OAR 437, Division 3 Construction, whichever applies. Permit spaces on the work site may consist of, but not be limited to, manholes, steel reservoirs, and trenches. The contractor shall provide written documentation, after award, regarding the permit space program the contractor will follow.

The Contractor or Subcontractor is not required to be licensed under ORS 468.883 for asbestos abatement.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the prevailing rate of wage must to be paid on this project in accordance with ORS 279C.840, and that the Contractor must ensure that the employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, marital status, age, or disability.

The City of Tualatin reserves the right to reject any proposal not in compliance with all prescribed public procedures and requirements, and may reject for good cause any or all proposals upon a finding that it is in the public interest to do so. Proposals cannot be withdrawn within 30 days after the actual date of proposal submittal deadline.
